Yu-Chi Sung is a professor in the Department of Civil Engineering at the National Taipei University of Technology (NTUT) and the division head in the Bridge Division at the National Center of Research on Earthquake Engineering (NCREE) in Taiwan. He received his Ph.D. degree in Civil Engineering from the National Taiwan University. He joined the National Taipei University of Technology in 2003, and before that he worked at the Taiwan Highway Bureau and the China Engineering Consultant Company over ten years as the bridge engineer. He has ever been awarded the Excellent Youth Engineer (1997) offered by the Chinese Institute of Engineers in Taiwan. He also designed some important bridges and got the awards of Best Design of Structure Engineering in 1998, 1999, 2002 and 2003, respectively, of the Chinese Society of Structural Engineering.

Dr. Sung research interests include performance-based design of the structure, structural optimization and natural hazard mitigation of the bridges. Dr. Sung was awarded the Best Paper offered by the Journal of Structural Engineering as well as the Journal of the Chinese Institute of Engineers in 2005 and 2007, respectively.
